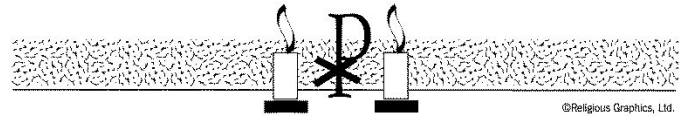

**ALL SAINTS' DAY/ALL SOULS DAY**

Thursday, November 1<sup>st</sup> is the Feast of All Saints. This is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics. The Mass schedule is:

Wed., Oct. 31 5:00 PM (Vigil Mass)

Thur., Nov. 1 8:30 AM and 6:00 PM

Friday, Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> is the Feast of All Souls. This is Not a Holy Day of Obligation. On this day we pray for all those who have died. Masses will be celebrated at 8:30 AM and 5:00 PM. At both Masses, the names of all those whose funeral was held at St John Vianney in the last year will be read.

**ALL SOULS' DAY ENVELOPES**

Every year, the parish has used All Souls Envelopes for parishioners and guests to make an offering in memory of deceased loved ones. These offerings go toward Masses which will be prayed throughout the year for the repose of all the souls included. The empty envelopes will be placed on the altar of remembrance, along with the Book of Remembrance, during November.

**THE BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE**

Each year parishioners are invited to write the names of deceased loved ones in a special book placed at the top of the ramp entrance to the church during the month of November. Praying for the dead is a spiritual work of mercy. Taking the time to write someone's name, and offering a prayer for them, is a holy thing to do.

**ALL SOULS' DAY PROCESSION TO RESURRECTION PARK**

On Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> after the 8:30 AM Mass, we will meet at the church and then process to Resurrection Park in honor of All Souls' Day. This will include prayers for those buried there and a blessing of the cemetery. All are invited to join us.
