THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE

Once again this year we will have a Thanksgiving Food Drive to help the less fortunate people in our communities through the Chittenden County Food Shelf. We will be collecting food the weekend before Thanksgiving (November 18/19), Thanksgiving Day (November 23) and the weekend after Thanksgiving (November 25/26). On November 20/21 we will take the food down for holiday meals and on November 27/28 we will take the rest of the food to replenish their shelves.

For the weekend of November 18/19 they are asking for "fresh foods" - potatoes, squash, carrots, onions *but nothing that needs immediate refrigeration*. Other Thanksgiving foods they are looking for are cranberry sauce, stuffing, canned green beans, Cream of Mushroom Soup, salad dressing, bread/cornbread mix and canned pumpkin pie filling.

On Thanksgiving Day and the weekend after they are asking for items to replenish their shelves. They are always in need of canned tuna, canned chicken, canned beef, flour, sugar, peanut butter, cereal, oatmeal, canned fruits, canned soups and chili, mac and cheese, hamburger helper, pasta and sauce, rice, juice and ready to eat snack foods.
