#### **MATTHEW TRACESKI**

Matthew Traceski grew up in Somers, Connecticut in a family of 8. Matt attended the University of Maine in Orono and earned a degree in Wildlife Ecology while working for State and private labs and departments. He entered priestly formation for the Diocese of Burlington in 2015 at Our Lady of Providence seminary in Rhode Island. After finishing Philosophy studies there, he began theology at Mt St Mary's Seminary in Maryland, where he is now in his second year. Matt taught Totus Tuus for two summers and has been assigned to St. Monica's in Barre and St. Paul's in Barton.

#### **LUAN TRAN**

Luan Tran was born into a large Catholic family of seven children in the North of Vietnam. His faith was fostered by his family, parish community, and youth groups. After graduating from Law School and working as a lawyer in Vietnam, he realized that God was calling him to priesthood. He approached the bishop of the diocese of Hanoi where he was living about becoming a priest. The bishop asked him if he would go to the US to serve the Church in America. After a long time of prayer, he decided to come to Vermont to receive his training. He is now learning English and studying American culture (with an emphasis on Vermont) at Saint Michael's College. He cannot wait to serve the Church in Vermont as a priest!
